


Replacing the Battery




Attaching Modules



WARNING

- ➤ To avoid electrical shock, always shut down the unit, and disconnect it from its external power source BEFORE removing a module
- Never remove a module while the unit is turned on. This will result in immediate and irreparable damage to both the module and unit.
- Position the module so that its back panel rests on a flat surface such as a table. The battery should be visible.
- Place the front panel on the module making sure that the mating connector of the module is well aligned with the corresponding slot on the front panel.
